Nomination deadlines and procedures	<p><b>1<sup>st</sup> July, 2024 (FOR ALL NOMINATIONS – 1<sup>st</sup> / 2<sup>nd</sup> sems &amp; full academic year)</b>  <b>(for later nominations, please check availability)</b></p> <p>Partner universities must email to the <b>International Office-Inbound Mobility</b> (<a href="mailto:erasmus-in@usal.es">erasmus-in@usal.es</a>) their official nomination lists including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Full name of the student/s</li> <li>• Email address</li> <li>• Study Area (ISCED code – please follow bilateral agreement)</li> <li>• Study level in Salamanca (Undergraduate / Master / Doctorate)</li> <li>• Study period (1<sup>st</sup> / winter sem, 2<sup>nd</sup> / summer sem or Full academic year)</li> </ul> <p>Splitting full-year mobilities into two single-semester mobilities is allowed as long as the balance in the distribution of students between 1<sup>st</sup> semester and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester is kept as set out in the agreement</p>

<b>Health &amp; Mobility insurances  (COMPULSORY)</b>	<p>Students from the EU, EFTA and Switzerland must apply for the <b>European Health Card (EHC)</b> at the health service offices in their country of origin (GHIC for UK students or A/T11 for Turkish students). Foreign students from <b>other countries</b> than the above-mentioned or who are not covered by national health plans must have <b>private health insurance</b>.</p> <p>The <b>Mobility Insurance of the University of Salamanca</b> is <b>mandatory</b> for all Erasmus students regardless of the requirements and/or regulations of the student’s home institution on the matter.
