# **REQUIREMENT (ELIGIBILITY)**

- Full time male and female undergraduate/graduate students in an accredited university or equivalent
- Students who have completed at least one semester at home university with GPA of 2.5/4.0 (75/100) or above
- Graduate students must provide official transcript of graduate-level studies at the stage of application.
- An official transcript must be ready at the stage of application

## **NOMINATION**

Nominations are made through Ewha Womans University online system. It is a required process for exchange students, visiting or fee-paying students does not need nomination form their home university. Detailed guidelines are sent to partner schools during the nomination period.

## LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

### **AIRPORT PICK-UP**

Ewha does not provide airport pickup service.

### **VISA**

Students must obtain D-2 student visa before their arrival. (Students with F-4 visa does not need D-2 visa.) Students need to submit documents to a local Korean Embassy or consulate to apply for the visa. Certificate of Admission and Business Registration Certificate of Ewha will be sent by Ewha to students.

## **HEALTH INSURANCE**

It is mandatory for students to obtain health insurance. Students may obtain their insurance at their home country or through Ewha Womans University. 

Cost of Ewha Collective Insurance: 42,000 KRW per semester and 60,000 KRW per year (Fees are subject to change). Additionally, the Ministry of Health and Welfare has implemented mandatory national health insurance for international students starting from March 2021. Students will need to obtain all necessary insurance to study in Korea.

## **HOUSING**

Ewha Womans University provides on-campus hosing for exchange/visiting students. However, it is designated on a first-come first-serve basis. Tuberculosis negative result issued on and after July 1<sup>st</sup> (Fall semester) or January 1<sup>st</sup> (Spring semester) is required for students who have applied for on-campus housing. \*\* subject to change
