Position

Working in a small and committed team, you will prepare and conduct research projects in the fields of entrepreneurship, strategy, and/or innovation, with the opportunity to write your doctoral thesis. Your tasks include identifying a research topic, collecting and analyzing data, and writing research articles. Major duties include preparing and giving tutorials, supervising dissertations at the undergraduate and graduate level, establishing and maintaining links to industry, or administrative duties as directed by the head of the group. Professor Walter will supervise your research and provide mentoring to develop your academic career if desired. A doctoral training program is offered by the School. The pay grade is 66% to 100% on TV-L, the German public sector scale. The post is fixed term for three years, with an extension option afterwards.

- Interest in the research fields of entrepreneurship, strategy, and innovation (essential)
- Outstanding Master's degree in management, economics, engineering, psychology, sociology or related fields (essential)
- Highly proficient in spoken and written English (essential), German language skills not required
- Independent working style, ability to work in teams, and passion for research (essential)
- Knowledge of quantitative research methods and software packages, e.g., SPSS and Stata (desirable)
